RULES AND REGULATIONS

For the Child:

- 1 – Each child will make every effort to attend all practices and games.
- 2 – Each child will give their best effort in practice and during each game.
- 3 – Each child will treat teammates, opponents, coaches, officials and administration personnel with respect.
- 4 – No Cursing is allowed.

For the Parent / Guardian:

- 1 – Fans are encouraged to root their team on positively, there will be no disrespectful comments made to any players, coaches, officials or administration personnel.
- 2 – If there is an issue do not speak through your child, bring it up to the coach, if there is an issue with the coach then bring it up to a league administrator. What may be an issue for you may not be for your child, let's work together on giving them a great experience.
- 3 – It is not encouraged to play multiple sports during a season but if that is the case do not miss a game for another sport, also chronic lateness or absence may mean less playing time. Your child has made a commitment to this team, others will depend on him/her to be there for practice and games.
- 4 – The coaches and administrators are volunteers who work hard to benefit the children of West Orange, if there is an issue that needs attention please bring it to the proper personnel to deal with. It doesn't help you, or your child to "air dirty laundry" in public.
